
Did you know... The capital of **Iceland**, Reykjavik, runs on geothermal power!

For even more captivating viking history, fjords and the beauty of Scandinavia, **Costsaver** has a 12 day adventure through Norway, Denmark and Sweden. <u>Highlights of Scandinavia</u> is a relatively affordable trip considering the affordability of Northern Europe, and pricing for June 12- June 23rd is only \$3570 for solos.



HANDS DOWN the popularity for Central and Eastern Europe has surpassed that of the West, and for a number of reasons....the main one being affordability. The further East you go, the further your dollar goes (with a few exceptions) and many of the cities you will not find nearly as busy as others such as Paris or London. However, that is changing. Just as the "cusp" months for travel before and after summer are becoming prime, the hidden gems of many of these countries are gaining in popularity and my true thought is the sooner you can get there the better.

Here are the top trips of 2020 based on all your interest, although in no particular order.

My heart is in Prague on the Charles Bridge



The only city untouched by Hitler in WWII, **Prague** in the Czech Republic is where I would go in Europe over and over again. Soups.....train stations with amazing potato pancakes...... and home of the BEST Garlic Cream soup I have found make it the first trip I would suggest for people to explore Europe. I chose the itinerary below because it includes Prague, Vienna and Budapest which are all places that should not be rushed through. I would even suggest arriving a few days early to have your own time and I have more than enough suggestions for you to enjoy day trips and all that you can get out of this magical city. With the change in the city and increasing tourists, it is strongly suggested that you avoid the summer months. Right now with Trafalgar, pricing through May, June and July don't vary so much, priced at \$2795 for a twin share, and \$3695 for solo accommodation. Prague, Vienna and Budapest

- 2- Their pricing- Trafalgar compares, and in many instances, beats the pricing of other competitors, but also has a sister brand, Costsaver, which is simply alternative accommodation for those who would like to budget a bit. Same tour, same experience but hotels outside the town centre.
- 3- CONNECT WITH LOCALS The unique opportunities segment of many tour companies began with Trafalgar. From private meals in the Vatican, or joining in with South African locals for a traditional meal and insight into their culture, every destination gives you an opportunity to experience something that you are guaranteed to never forget.
- 4- STAYS WITH STORIES- Every tour destination has one special night of accommodation that has been picked for a very special reason. Whether it be historical importance, societal significance, or a unique wow factor, each has its own story to tell, that will "stay with" you.
- 5- THEIR DEPOSIT POLICY- If you have placed a deposit down on a trip, and events change preventing you from going, Trafalgar will hold that deposit for 5 YEARS to apply to another

<u>Country Roads of Croatia</u> is a 14 day, 13 night adventure that begins in **Zagreb** and ends in **Dubrovnik**. Your best bet considering weather and pricing is tour dates of May23-June 5th and is \$6093 including the solo supplement.

Some great highlights to consider about **Insight Vacations** if you are not familiar with the company:

- dining Michelin star, cooking lessons/demonstrations, truly local specialty restaurants, farm-to-table
- hotels hand picked, boutique, most desirable locations
- coach leg room between seats is HUGE. The windows are great for viewing. They do a seat rotation plan so everyone gets a chance to sit at the front. Electrical outlets to ensure you are charged. Smaller groups max 40 seater buses.
- travel director are employed all year and do training in off season. They often break the group into smaller sub groups with a local expert to be more manageable and more enjoyable visits. They often have tours after hours when all the tourists have gone.
- make travel matter they are looking at the bigger picture with projects that support the planet, wildlife and culture of the destination. A new initiative is they are supporting reforestation right here in BC!
