<u>Day 1-</u>

Your tour starts with collection at an agreed point and time in Edinburgh. Then it's a short trip over to the Clyde Coast to the Spinnaker Hotel. Once checked to your sea view rooms you will have the opportunity to relax and have a drink or coffee at the bar and admire the views over the River Clyde. Or maybe take a stroll along the water front.

Your host Stewart will join you for dinner that evening to discuss the trip in more detail

<u>Day 2-</u>

Our first real look at the Clyde Coast. After a full Scottish Breakfast we will take a tour of the local area starting at 11.00 am. See the magnificent views and places of interest, and then we stop at Largs one of the nicest towns on the Clyde where we have 2 hours to explore the town. A must is a visit to Nardinis- for the most famous ice cream in Scotland.

In the evening I can suggest somewhere for eating, if the party does not wish to eat at the Hotel

<u>Day 3-</u>

Its St Andrews today. We will pick up everyone at 9.00 am and arrive at St Andrews for about 11.00 am. Giving you 4 hours to discover the Home of Golf, the beach front, the town of St Andrews and some lunch.

The Scottish theme continues in the evening with a Scottish night, some whisky tasting, haggis and some traditional Scottish songs. Staring 7.30 pm

<u>Day 4-</u>

Day starts at 9.00 am with a short ferry crossing over the Clyde. Then it's on to Oban stopping at Inveraray. The drive is through some of the most beautiful scenery Scotland has to offer. With at least 3 hours in Oban where there will be plenty of time to explore this beautiful little town. On the way back we stop at the Drovers Inn- Scotland's oldest public house and made famous by Rob Roy. As we continue through Loch Lomond we also take a further stop at the Luss a small picturesque village on the Bonnie Banks of Loch Lomond.

<u>Day 5-</u>

Departing at 9.00 am on our way up to Inverness. Stopping at the Perthshire village of Pitlochry. It's then on to Culloden the site of the last stand of The Jacobite Army led by Bonnie Prince Charlie. Then it's onto Inverness with a couple of hours to look round the Highland Capital. Saying the night in the area where evening meal is included. There will be plenty of time in the evening to explore the beautiful grounds and countryside.

<u>Day 6-</u>

Departing at 9.00 am on our way to Skye. Stopping at Loch Ness and maybe just maybe we might see Nessie. Its then onto Skye where we will have at least 4 hours to explore parts of the Island. Then it's a short drive to Eilean Donan where we will be staying the night. The Eilean Donan Castle is the most famous and most pictured Castle in Scotland. Evening Meal is provided at this location.

<u>Day 7-</u>

Departing at 11.30 to allow everyone time to explore the Castle and local area. We stop off at Fort William as we travel back South to the Clyde Coast.

<u>Day 8-</u>

Two of Scotland's treasures in one day. Whisky and Wallace. We leave the Hotel at 11.00 am to arrive at the distillery for a tour at 12.00 pm. From there we travel through to the Wallace Monument arriving about 3.00 pm. Its then back to base for sadly our last night on the tour. I would like to join the party in the evening for something to eat.

Day 9- Friday 30th August

Collection at Hotel at 8.00 am to arrive at airport for next destination

<u>Notes</u>

- 1. Evening meals will be included on three nights; drinks are extra on this package. These meals are for the Scottish Night, Inverness and Eilean Donan.
- 2. All nights are booked including breakfast.
- 3. All attractions have entry fees as previously listed.
- 4. Our van will include water, soft drinks and some small snacks only.
- 5. Collection and return will be in two vehicles to allow space for luggage.
- 6. For the two overnight stays we will provide smaller cases which can be used for these dates.
- 7. Remainder of Luggage will be stored securely at our first Hotel.
- 8. Return transfer is to Edinburgh Airport, please can this time be confirmed.
- 9. All timings are subject to change due to any unforeseen traffic issues.
- 10. All hotels will be paid in full before arrival; any extras can be charged to your rooms and settled up on departure directly with the Hotel.
- 11. All other extras such as snacks, drinks, lunches etc are not included in the price
- 12. Deposit payable of £170 per person UK pounds. Deposit is non refundable
- 13. All prices are based on a party of 7.
- 14. Weather in Scotland can be unpredictable at this time of year with average temperatures of 17 degrees. Suggest that a light rain jacket is included along with sun screen and some repellent for the Midges.
- 15. Regardless of the weather, I will personally insure you have a wonderful stay in Scotland with memories that will last a life time.
