Canadians Traveling to Europe

On July 1 **Canada** was one of 10 countries the European Council announced should be <u>allowed to travel</u> <u>to the region for non-essential purposes</u>. The announcement brings the total number of countries on that list to 23.

However, it remains up to the member states of the EU to decide whether they'd like to begin that process of reopening their borders to tourists. Each EU country has their own rules.

There has been a lot of talk about the **EU Digital Health Certificate** – please note this is for those living in the EU --- <u>Canadians do NOT need to get this.</u>

France

Can Canadians enter France? Yes, Canadians may now enter France for tourism if they are fully vaccinated.

Is quarantine mandatory for Canadians entering France? No, it isn't, for vaccinated travelers who also present a negative PCR test.

Is the PCR test mandatory for Canadians traveling to France now? Yes, the test is mandatory.

Other important information for Canadians who want to visit France A night curfew is still in place between 9:00 PM and 6:00 AM. It should be totally lifted on June 30. People can leave their homes during the day without justification forms. Restaurants and bars are open for outdoor and indoor serving with limited capacity. Non-essential businesses and cultural venues can operate if they can ensure 8 square meters per customer.

Greece

Can Canadians enter Greece? Yes, Canadians may now visit Greece.

Is quarantine mandatory for Canadians entering Greece? No, it isn't.

Is the PCR test mandatory for Canadians traveling now? PCR tests are not required for Canadians entering Greece, but travelers are encouraged to take the test whenever possible.

Other important information for Canadians who want to visit Greece The Greek government will cover the expenses of hospitalization of travelers who get infected with COVID-19. Hotels are very flexible, if a traveler gets infected with COVID-19, the accommodation expenses may be refunded.

Ireland

Can Canadians enter Ireland?

Yes, Canadian citizens are now allowed to enter Ireland for tourism. All travelers need to complete a Passenger Locator Form at least 48 hours before entering Ireland. Details can be checked here.

Is quarantine mandatory for Canadians entering Ireland? No, quarantine is not mandatory if you are vaccinated or tested negative for COVID.

Is the PCR test mandatory for Canadians traveling now? Yes, a negative PCR test is required to enter Ireland, if you are not vaccinated yet.

Other important information for Canadians who want to visit Ireland Restaurants are operating with outdoor services. Gyms and swimming pools are allowed to operate for individual training. More details can be found here.
